3. Only NTIL grades given by BTTSAL or tutors registered under BTTSAL would be recognised by MOE and recorded with other school results for in-school progression.
4. Upon progression to secondary and pre-university levels, students who have been granted approval to offer NTIL will continue to offer the language at the GCE 'O' and 'A' Level examinations.
