Dear Parents / Guardians,

Welcome to Term 2 of 2022!

Thank you for partnering the school in developing our Clementians to be concerned citizens and self-directed learners. I want to thank you for your strong support at the Networking Session with Form Teachers conducted over two sessions on 14 and 21 January 2022. Thank you for taking time to get to know our teachers and partner the school in the holistic development of your child/ward.

From the feedback received, I am heartened to know that you have found the Networking Session to be useful in providing insights into how you can partner the school in better supporting your child/ward in their learning and development in school.

To promote a greater sense of ownership of classrooms' cleanliness in Clementians, the school is running the inaugural Clean-It-Right Championship. Through this initiative, we hope to see all Clementians play a more active role in keeping the school environment as well as the community environment a clean and conducive one. Kindly continue to reinforce the message of a clean Singapore always to your children.

To provide leadership platforms and opportunities for our Clementians, our prefects, sports leaders and NE Ambassadors have been conducting a weekly ZOOM sharing to the school population on various topics like keeping the environment clean and on sharing details of events like Chinese New Year and Total Defence Day. As they prepare their sharing materials and hone their public speaking skills, we hope they will gain confidence and influence amongst the student population. We hope that all Clementians will also aspire to be leaders of themselves and others, in line with our school vision of A Leader. A Keen Learner. A Friend. In Term 2, we will be recognizing our Student Leaders during the Student Leaders Investiture which will be held on 29 March 2022.

1. **Safe Management Measures**

1.1. As a nation, we are seeing a surge in the number of Covid-19 cases due to the Omicron strain. This has inevitably led to more Covid-19 cases in schools. We would like to assure you that all schools remain vigilant in our fight against Covid-19 and have in place robust Safe Management Measures (SMMs) to ensure the safety of our school population. The SMMs include the following:

- a) Daily temperature-taking with additional visual screening for all students and staff.
- b) Clementians and staff are required to wear their face masks/shields.
- c) Clementians are reminded to practice frequent hand-washing throughout the school day and carry out wipe-down routines like cleaning tables and shared equipment after use.

- d) Intermingling across classes and levels is minimised.
 - e) Staggered recess and dismissal times for different levels and designated gates.
 - f) Our school will clean high-touch surfaces more frequently and disinfect our premises daily.
 - g) Clementians are required to carry their TT token to school and have it with them throughout the day to facilitate accurate contact tracing.
- 1.2. MOE continues to monitor the situation closely and we are guided by MOH guidelines. Please refer to the following URLs to get more information on COVID-19:

- 1.3. Clementians are required to carry their TraceTogether (TT) token to school and have it with them throughout the day to facilitate accurate contact tracing. Parents are to ensure that the TraceT Tokens are in working condition. Clementians are expected to take good care of the TT tokens issued to them. They are required to personalise their TT tokens (e.g. using permanent/paint markers to write their name/school/class) to facilitate the returning of the tokens to the rightful owners.
- 1.4. We seek all parents' cooperation to exercise personal and social responsibility to help keep our school safe. Parents are reminded to continue to monitor their child's health, and seek medical attention immediately, if unwell. Parents are also reminded to ensure that their child observes good personal hygiene, practices safe distancing and wears masks when leaving home. For Clementians on Health Risk Notice (HRN), parents are to ensure that their child tests ART negative before leaving home in the morning.
