Dear Parents / Guardians,

Welcome to Term Two of 2018! In Term 1, our school had undergone a large-scale emergency exercise on 1 Feb 2018. We would like to commend our children for their vigilance and cooperation. With the introduction of informal assessment last year, we would like to thank you for your partnership with us to enable your child to take greater ownership of his / her learning, by supporting the use of online quizzes for re-testing at home.

This year, the school has adopted Google Classroom for all Primary 1 to 6 Clementians to improve learning through appropriate use of Information and Communications Technology (ICT). Google Classroom seamlessly integrates with other Google tools and helps teachers refresh their curriculum with integrated education apps. With Google Classroom, classroom teachers can create classes, distribute assignments, send feedback, and enable online collaboration to deepen pupils' learning and problem-solving abilities. Teachers can also manage assignments and communicate with your child/ward conveniently on the online platform.

1. Communication with Parents

2. Child-Teacher-Parent (CTP) Conference 2018

In our efforts to accommodate more Clementians and their parents, we will be holding our CTP Conference over one and a half days instead of one day as in previous years. CTP Conference will be held on **24 May 2017 (Thu) from 2 pm to 4.30 pm and 25 May 2018 (Fri) from 8 am to 4.30 pm**. The session will allow our teachers to conference with you and your child/ward with regard to his/her learning progress.

Lessons **will be suspended** on 25 May 2018 (Fri) and your child/ward need not report to school as usual. Instead, your child should come to school with you for the CTP Conference based on the time-slot allocated. Please ensure that your child comes in school uniform. More information of the CTP conference and instructions on the booking of an appointment for the conference will be given at a later date.

3. Traffic Updates

We appreciate your cooperation in ensuring smooth vehicular movement in the morning. This is a gentle reminder to all drivers. Please:

- Stay on the left lane patiently to wait for your turn to drive into the school. Overtaking the vehicles turning into Clementi Town Secondary School (CTSS) will **likely** result in you blocking the vehicles on the right lane, causing traffic on both lanes to be blocked.
- Stop your vehicle at the alighting point that is furthest along the driveway. The covered driveway can accommodate four vehicles at a time.
- Remind your child to sit on the passenger side of the car and alight as soon as your vehicle comes to a stop.
- Place your child's school bag within easy access for him/her before leaving home, and allow your child to alight by himself/ herself independently to avoid holding up the traffic behind you.
- Drive carefully when it rains. Any delay in getting to school on such days is understandable.

During school dismissal, please DO NOT park along the road outside the school to wait for your child.

Please reinforce safety messages to your children who are walking along the car park entrance and exit of Clementi Cascadia precinct entrance to get to school. All road users are to adhere to the safety measures that have been put in place.

Let us all show consideration for others and emphasise road safety, so that we can be positive role models to our Clementians.

4. Updates on PERI Upgrading Works

We are pleased to share with you that the PERI Upgrading is nearing its completion and Clementians will be able to enjoy new facilities to enhance their schooling experience in term 3. As part of the upgrading, the current temporary sheltered walkway will be removed with effect from 19 March 2018. Please refer to Annex A for Gate 1 to facilitate safe access into the school during the period of construction. Vehicular movement in the morning will not be affected.

The school has conducted safety briefings for all Clementians on the 9 March 2018 to familiarise them with how to access Gate 1. Staff members will be stationed at the side gate to guide Clementians into the school compound when the school term reopens.
