## 1. Principal's Note

I would like to thank the parents who attended the In-Conversation with Principal session on 2 November 2018. During the session, we had a fruitful conversation on topics that ranged from partnering parents in the development of holistic education to school-based assessment. ## 3. Singapore Student Learning Space (SLS)

It promotes self-directed learning where Clementians can learn at their own pace, revisit concepts learnt and read up on other areas of interest. ## 4. Stay Safe Online

While allowing your child to spend some time online during the holidays, it is also important for your child to stay safe online. You can refer to the cyber-wellness briefing slides and tip sheets for parents on our school website. We hope to raise our Clementians' awareness to protect themselves and empower them to take responsibility for their well-being online.

## 5. Travel Declaration for Year-end Holidays

If you have a child/ward in Primary 1, please make a declaration of your child's/ward's travel plans during the school holidays. A **NIL Return** is required even if you are not planning to travel.

If your child/ward is in the other levels (P2 to P6), kindly make a declaration of your child's/ward's travel plans only if your child/ward is travelling out of Singapore.

Please make your declaration by **Monday, 19 November 2018**.

If there are changes to your travel plans after your submission, please update us by resubmitting your amended travel plans online. It is important that information provided on your child's/ward's travel plans is as accurate and current as possible.

If your child/ward is unwell, or develops flu-like symptoms after an overseas trip during this year-end holiday, please take the following actions immediately:

- (1) Inform the school;
- (2) Bring your child/ward to see a doctor;
- (3) Refrain your child/ward from coming back to school until he/she has recovered.

## 6. Temperature-taking Exercise in 2019

As part of the school's measures to maintain a high level of emergency preparedness, your child is required to bring along his/her Oral Digital Thermometers (ODTs) on the following days:

- **3 January 2019 (Thursday)**
- **4 January 2019 (Friday)**

We would like to seek your assistance to replace the batteries of the ODT or buy a new one if his/her ODT is found not to be working during the pre-exercise check on **3 January 2019, Thursday**.

## 7. Information on 2019 Direct School Admission for Secondary Schools (DSA-Sec)

From 2019, you and your child will be able to apply to all DSA-Sec schools using a new online DSA-Sec Portal. The portal will simplify and streamline the DSA application process, making it convenient for all students. Students interested to apply to Singapore School of the Arts (SOTA) or Singapore Sports School (SSP) should continue to apply directly to the school.
